Monika Maria Lisatowicz has been named the new president of Polish Ship Salvage. She focuses on teamwork and motivation

There has been a change in the position of CEO at Polskie Ratownictwo Okrętowe Sp. z o.o.. The Ordinary Meeting of Shareholders appointed Monika Maria Lisatowicz, who has been with the company for more than 22 years, to serve in this position for a new fifth term. The new president began her tenure on July 25, the day

after the Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting adopted the financial statements for the 2023 fiscal year.

Monika Lisatowicz holds university and postgraduate degrees in management, economics, marketing, human resources management, labor law and safety, and has been with PRO for more than 22 years. The new president began her career at the company as a human resources and administration specialist, also serving as an assistant to the then managing director Stanislaw Rutkowski, to whom (as she says) she owes the opportunity to start working and develop professionally at the shipowner's company.

In 2012 and 2016-2017 she was a member of the PRO Supervisory Board as a representative elected by the employees. As of 2017, in addition to serving as an ISM/ MLC/ISO representative and QHSE manager, she was a director in PRO's group subsidiaries.

The new CEO focuses on teamwork in a good atmosphere and motivation.

- Together we have weathered the storms and only together will we achieve success. I decided to run for the position of CEO because I am very familiar with the specifics of the operation of a shipowning company, which is a state-owned company and operates as part of a capital group. I know and am connected with the entire team, both the administrative staff and the sailing crews. In fact, it is thanks to them, thanks to their work, that I am where I am," says Monika Lisatowicz.

According to the new president, the right strategy is a key element for ensuring financial security and growth in the domestic and international markets.

- Taking into account the current situation of PRO and the capital group, as the basic assumptions for development should be indicated, first of all, the need to implement measures to ensure profitability and expand the sales offer, modernization and renewal of the fleet, as well as restructuring including consolidation of the capital group structure, "states the new president of PRO.
